

Endemicity of *S. mansoni* infections at community level prior to PCT interventions

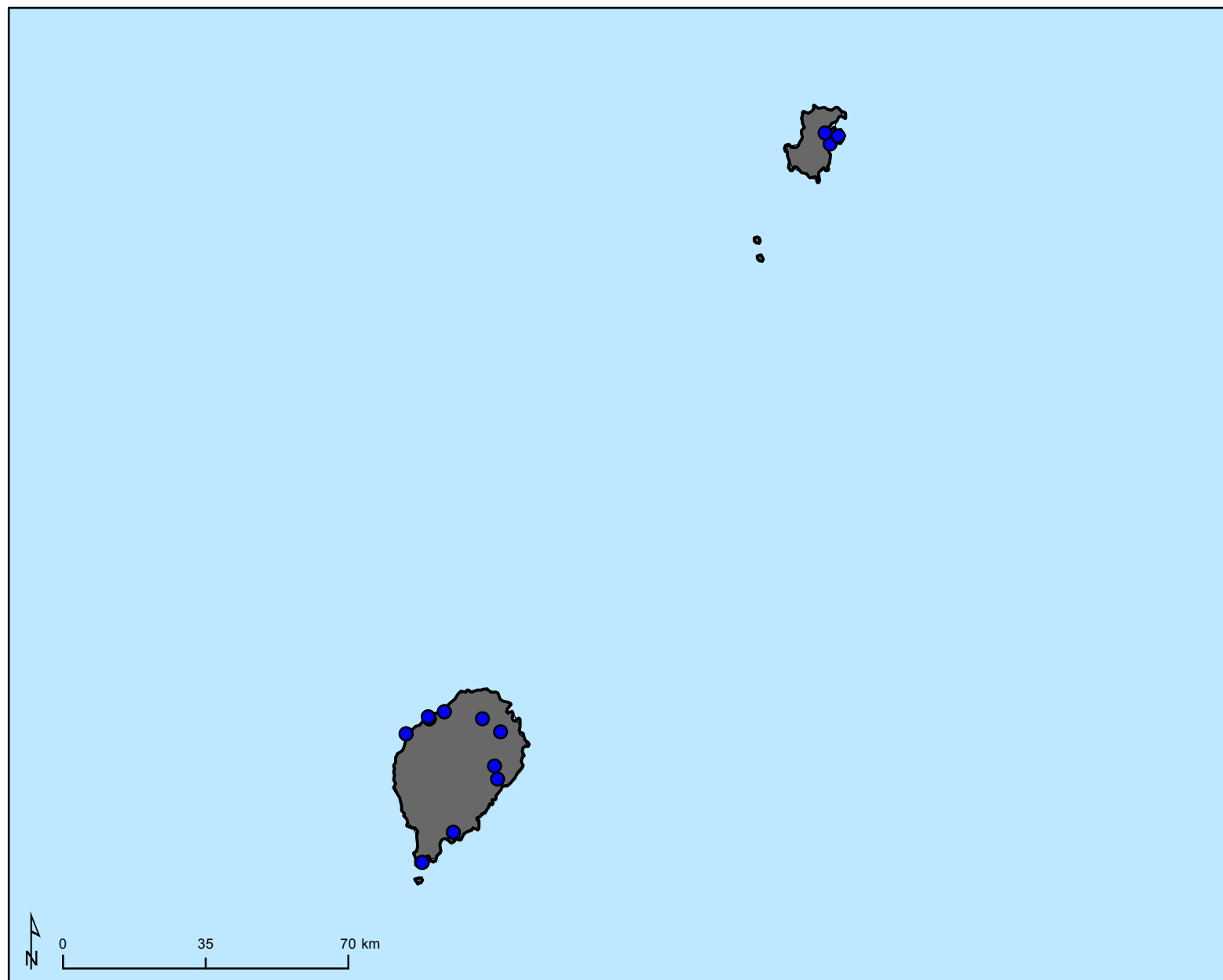
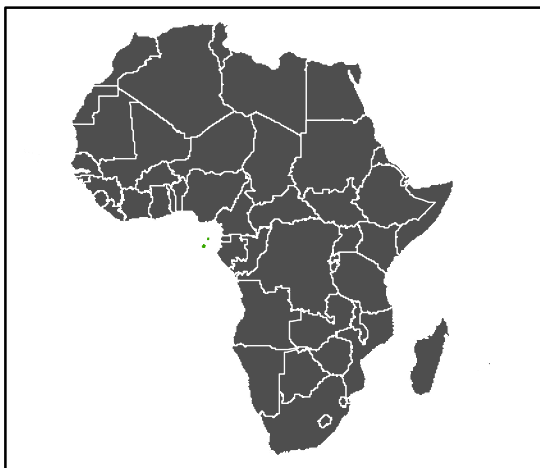
