#### **Date & Place**

- Hôtel SARAKAWA on the seafront in Lomé, the capital of Togo
- 4 April 15 to 17, 2025

#### Visa and travel

- ♣ All visa applications MUST be made online at https://voyage.gouv.tg/myspace/travel?wish=visa at least 7 days before your arrival in Togo. The issuance of entry visas to Togo in "EXPRESS mode" is suspended.
- Make sure you receive an electronic visa confirmation code before departure.
- 4 The visa fee is €35. The visa granted online 48h will be stamped on arrival at the airport
- Persons with a United Nations Laissez-Passer (UNLP) and ECOWAS citizens are exempt from the visa requirement
- ♣ Regardless of nationality, all travelers must comply with immigration formalities. When filling in the online immigration form, a QR code is generated. This QR code must be presented to immigration upon disembarkation, along with the passport.

- ♣ Accommodation will be at the SARAKAWA Hotel: each participant is responsible for covering their hotel expenses, except for those sponsored by WHO, whose accommodation costs have been deducted in advance.
- ♣ The negotiated price is 73000 FCFA (or 115USD/night).


